### Jackson's Electric Glove May Fetch \$80,000, Auction House Says

July 1 (Bloomberg) -- [Michael Jackson](#)'s illuminated white glove, worn on stage during his 1984 "Victory" tour, may fetch as much as \$80,000, according to the president of the auction house that will put it up for sale in October.

The battery-powered glove, adorned with crystals and 50 small lights, is one of two created for the tour, Profiles in History, a Calabasas, California-based auction house, said today in a statement. It will be sold along with several other Jackson items Oct. 1 and Oct. 2, it said.

The planned auction reflects increased interest in Jackson memorabilia since his June 25 death. Last week, a collection of Jackson items, including a shirt worn on the

same tour, brought in \$205,000 at auction, more than pre-sale projections of \$10,000 to \$12,000. The glove's estimated price is conservative, [Profiles in History](#) President [Joseph Maddalena](#) said.

“The interest has been huge,” Maddalena said in an interview. “Way more than anything I’ve had before.”

The illuminated glove will be put on display at the Comic-Con entertainment convention in San Diego this month, [Profiles in History](#) said.

Jackson was pronounced dead at the UCLA Ronald Reagan Medical Center after suffering an apparent cardiac arrest, the hospital said at the time.
