On The Auction Block

Charlton Heston died in April 2008, but you can display him in your living room as Moses for an estimated \$3,000 to \$5,000.

The Hollywood Wax Museum is selling more than 200 of its figures. Along with the political, music and movie stars are several

religious ones that will be auctioned Friday.

Heston as Moses from the 1956 movie "The Ten Commandments" was one of the first figures made for the museum, according to auction information. He stands 6 feet 4 inches tall, from white hair to sandals, and holds the sacred tablets, constructed from foam.

The collection up for bid also includes a couple Christs on the cross, one resurrected Christ, two Last Suppers and a nativity.

The Christ images are estimated to go for \$2,000 to \$5,000.

One of the Last Suppers, featuring Jesus and his 12 disciples, is made of papier-mâché over chicken wire. A couple of the disciples are missing thumbs, but the display is still expected to fetch between \$8,000 and \$10,000. The other is estimated to sell for \$6,000 to \$8,000.

The nativity -- with Mary, Joseph, baby Jesus and three Magi -- is estimated to go for about the
